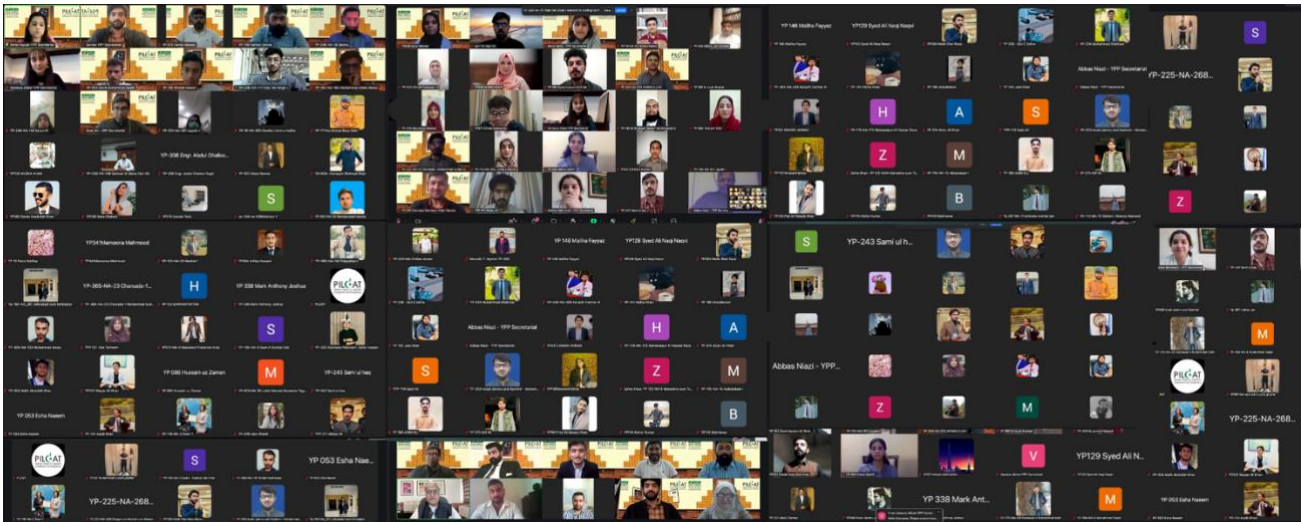

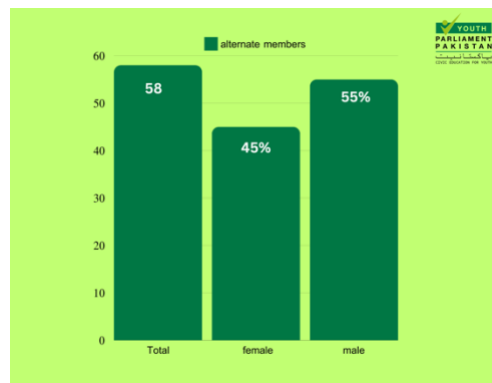
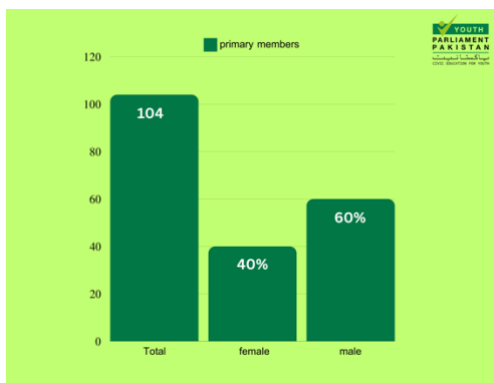
Third Virtual Session of the 18th Youth Parliament Pakistan®



The 18th batch of the Youth Parliament Pakistan®, convened its third virtual session on April 27, 2024. This session, held online, included primary members & alternate members representing all National Assembly constituencies of Pakistan, including Azad Jammu & Kashmir, Gilgit-Baltistan, and Overseas Pakistanis. The day's agenda included key activities such as presentations on the Quality of General Election 2024 and on the Role & Responsibilities of YPP Committees, followed by elections for YPP Standing Committees and an insightful Q&A session that included discussions on future governance.

MYPs in Attendance:

The session saw a diverse participation of MYPs. Out of the **104 primary members**, 40% were female and 60% were male. Among the **54 alternate members**, the gender distribution was 45% female and 55% male. This balanced representation underscores the Youth Parliament Pakistan’s commitment to inclusivity and equal participation.



Opening & Welcome Address:

The session commenced with a traditional recitation, followed by a warm welcome from Ms. Amna Kausar, Acting Speaker of the session and Senior Projects Manager at PILDAT/YPP. Ms. Kausar appreciated the participants' dedication and highlighted the significance of the discussions ahead.

Presentation on the Quality of General Election 2024:

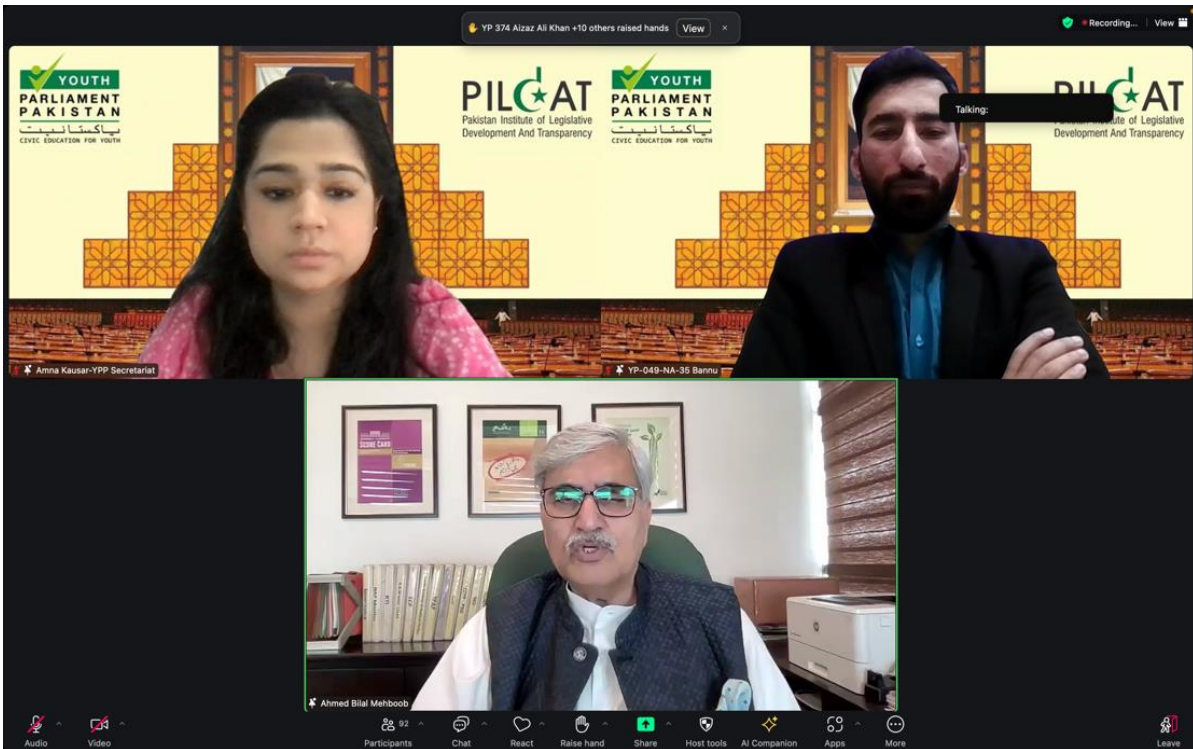
The session proceeded with a presentation by Ms. Alena Sadiq, Projects Officer at PILDAT, on the **"Assessment of the Quality of General Election 2024."** Her presentation outlined the evolution of Pakistan's electoral process since 2002, focusing on the three critical phases: pre-poll, polling day, and post-poll. Ms. Sadiq detailed the methodology and process of the PILDAT survey, which assessed fairness and identified key issues during each phase. The presentation also addressed speculations about the Election Management System (EMS) and the Election Commission of Pakistan's (ECP) justifications for its use. A comparative assessment of election quality was provided, along with recommendations for the ECP and Parliament to enhance the electoral process.

Q&A Session:

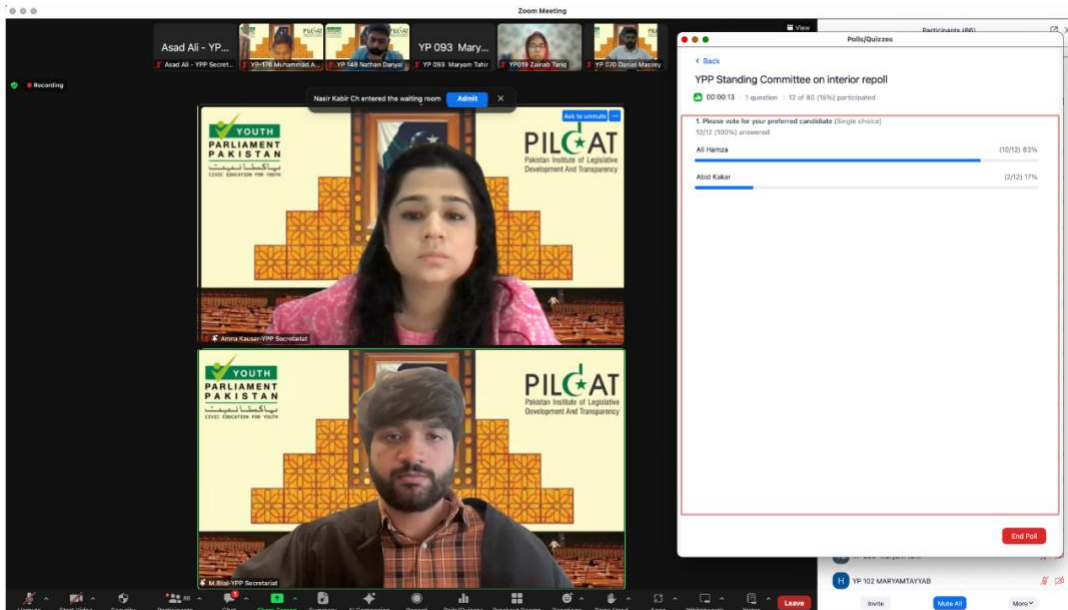
Following the presentation, an interactive Q&A session allowed Members of the Youth Parliament Pakistan® to share their perspectives and raise critical questions. Topics discussed included the impartiality of the ECP, the need for a transparent Judicial Commission, and concerns over the ECP's reliance on technology. MYPs also debated youth participation in future elections, the Charter of Democracy, and the manipulation of forms 45 and 47. They also emphasized on the importance of including an analysis of election budget spending in future reports.

Elections for YPP Standing Committees:

Following the presentation, the session proceeded with the elections for the remaining YPP Standing Committees, presided over by Acting Deputy Speaker Mr. Saryan Ajmal. **14 standing committees** were established, and **56 office-bearers** were elected through virtual voting. Each committee elected a Chairperson, Deputy Chairperson, Secretary, and Joint Secretary. Committees covered diverse areas such as Foreign Relations, National Security, Health, Science & Technology, Climate Change, and Law and Justice

Presentation on the Role & Responsibilities of YPP Standing Committees:

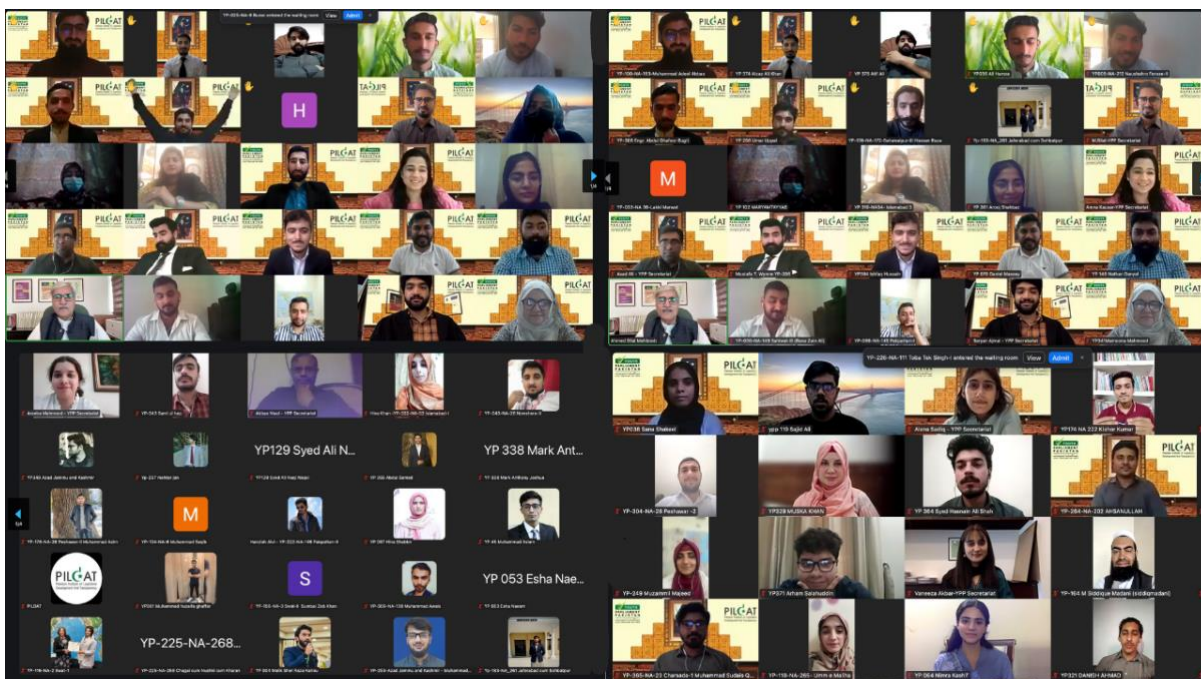
